CHRISTMAS PARTIES

NON-UNIFORM ON PARTY DAYS

Please remember the children do not have to wear uniform on party days but they will need suitable clothes i.e. a coat for playtime and suitable footwear for party games and outdoor play.

JUNIOR CHRISTMAS PARTY -

TUESDAY 11TH DECEMBER

The junior party food is split into Savoury & Sweets with the Year 3 & 4 children bringing in something savoury (e.g. sandwiches, filled rolls, breadsticks, pizza slices, crisps, chicken nuggets etc.) and Year 5 & 6 bringing in something sweet (e.g. biscuits, small cakes). This will need to be brought in on the morning of the 11th December and put on to the buffet table which will be set up in the hall. Please label all plates, bowls etc. with your child's name and class so they can be returned. Your child will not need a packed lunch on this day.
