



BAD WEATHER POLICY - PUPILS

Obviously snow and ice can appear and disappear very quickly and weather forecasts are not always reliable, but the following guidelines should cover all eventualities:-

- a) If snow is falling rapidly and settling in significant amounts by the end of the school day and the weather forecast is for it to continue through the night, we may issue a note to pupils saying that the school will be closed the next day.
- b) If the weather is bad overnight, we will make a decision regarding closure by 7.30am at the latest. Usually, if other Spalding Schools are closed, Ayscoughfee will follow, especially as many of our parents have further to travel.

Information on school closure will be sent by Parentmail to all parents who have signed up to receive this service. The School Website will also carry this information as well as our Facebook page.

If at any time bad weather begins to close in during the day, then parents are welcome to contact the school to see if they may take their children early, in order to ensure a safe journey home.

Any reference to the word 'School' implicitly includes all its associated clubs/activities including Kids Club. This policy also applies to EYFS
