FLAG FEN YEAR 3 TRIP

During our visit to Flag Fen, Year 3 discovered what life was like for British Celts 3,000 years ago. They became field archaeologists for a day and handled Roman and Celtic artefacts, created Celtic and Roman pottery and searched the roundhouse for clues about the life of Celts. They also got a chance to see an uncovered section of the ritual causeway running through the Flag Fen site and the Bronze Age log boats discovered at Must Farm.
